After living in war-torn Vietnam, Moon, her parents and 10 other children were given refugee status and evacuated by ship to begin a new life. From Vietnam in April 1975 to the Philippines, Hawaii, California, Indiantown Gap and finally Hanover, the journey took seven months!

Moon was determined to make a new life in America and volunteered at Hanover's library and hospital to learn English and worked at several jobs in Hanover before opening Moon's Café at the Market House in Hanover in 1985.
