# Hanover Area Historical Society

The **Hanover Area Historical Society (HAHS)** was founded in 1965 by local citizens. The Society's mission is to preserve, protect and promote the historical story of the Hanover area. HAHS selectively acquires, preserves and provides access to historical buildings, sites, artifacts and archives that have unique historical significance for the area. The Society provides related programs and activities for the educational, recreational and cultural benefit of the people of the area.



In 1974, HAHS purchased and restored the **Neas House** (c. 1783) at Chestnut and High Streets. All the funding for the purchase and the repairs came from the community. Open 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays from 12:00-3:00 p.m. or by appointment (closed January-March). The Neas House is on the National Register of Historic Places.

In 2007, HAHS was given the **Warehime-Myers Mansion** (c. 1911-1913), which is open for public tours on Wednesdays 10:00-3:00 and Saturdays, 12:00-3:00. (Last tour begins at 2:30; closed January-March.) Mansion and grounds are available to rent.



The Carriage House behind the Mansion holds our **Hanover Area History Museum®**. Hours are the same as the Mansion.

The **Yelland Research Library & Archives**, located in the **Hormel History & Research Center**, offers a varied collection of resources pertaining to the area's history and genealogical information. Visit our website for hours or call for an appointment.
